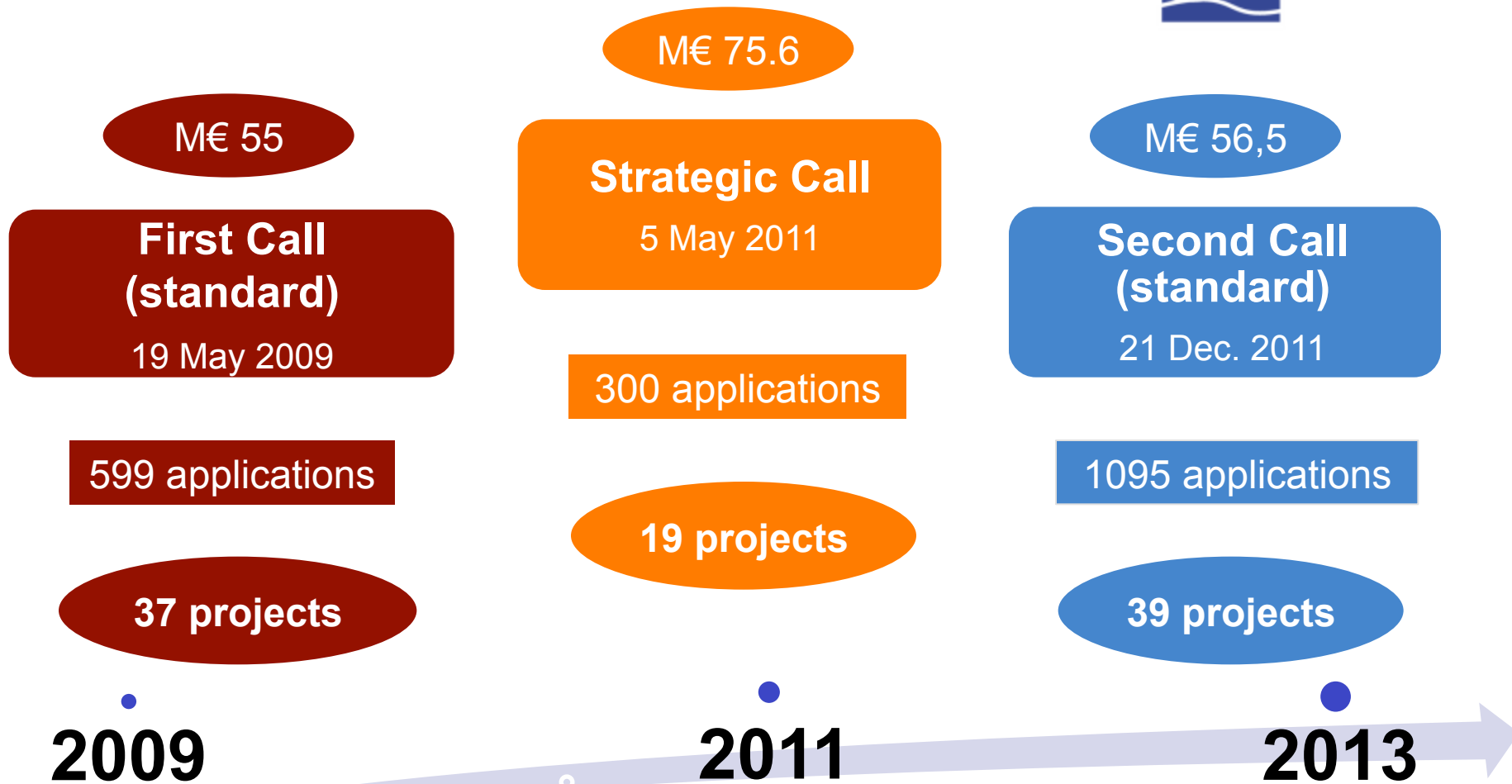

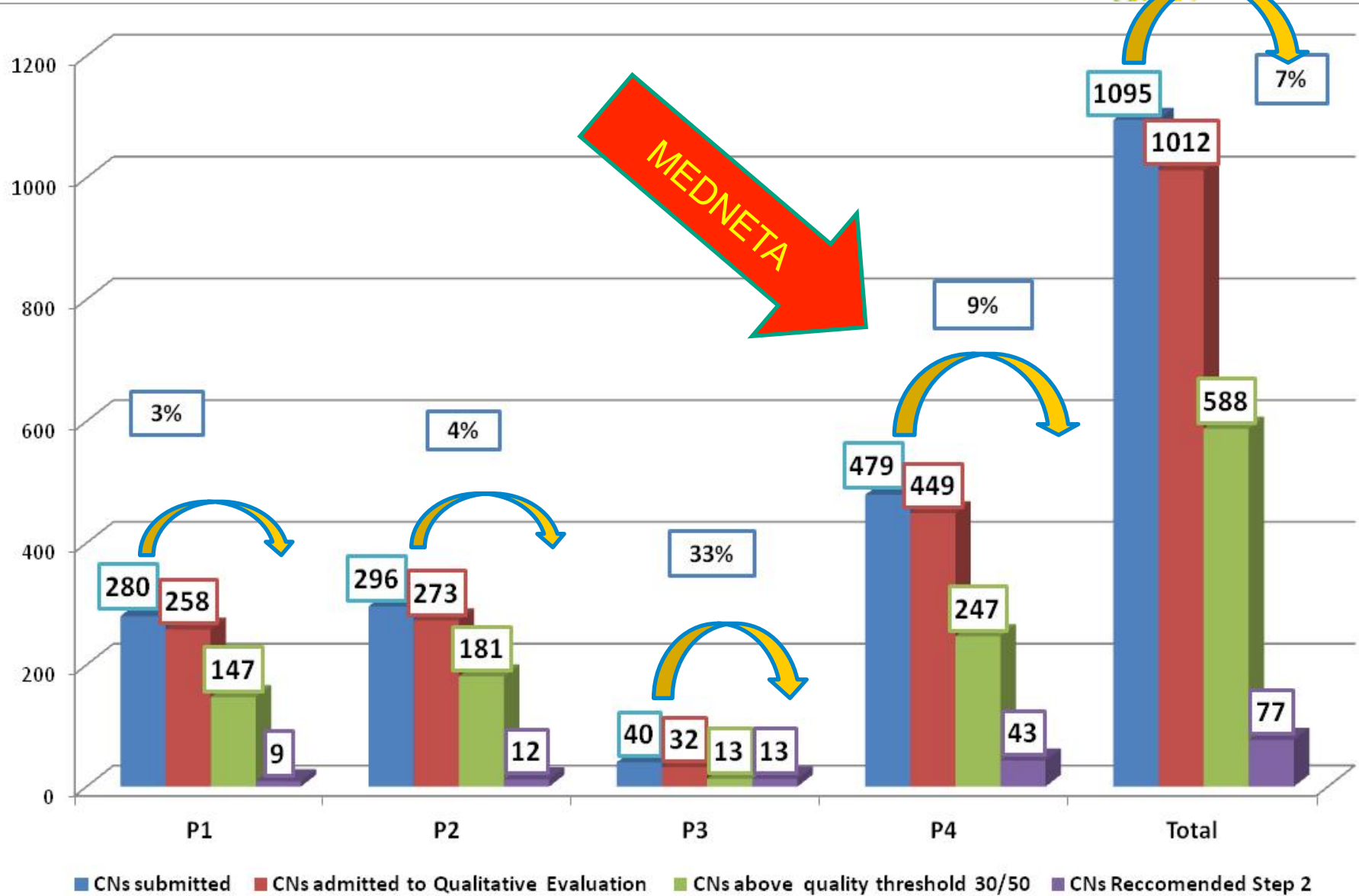

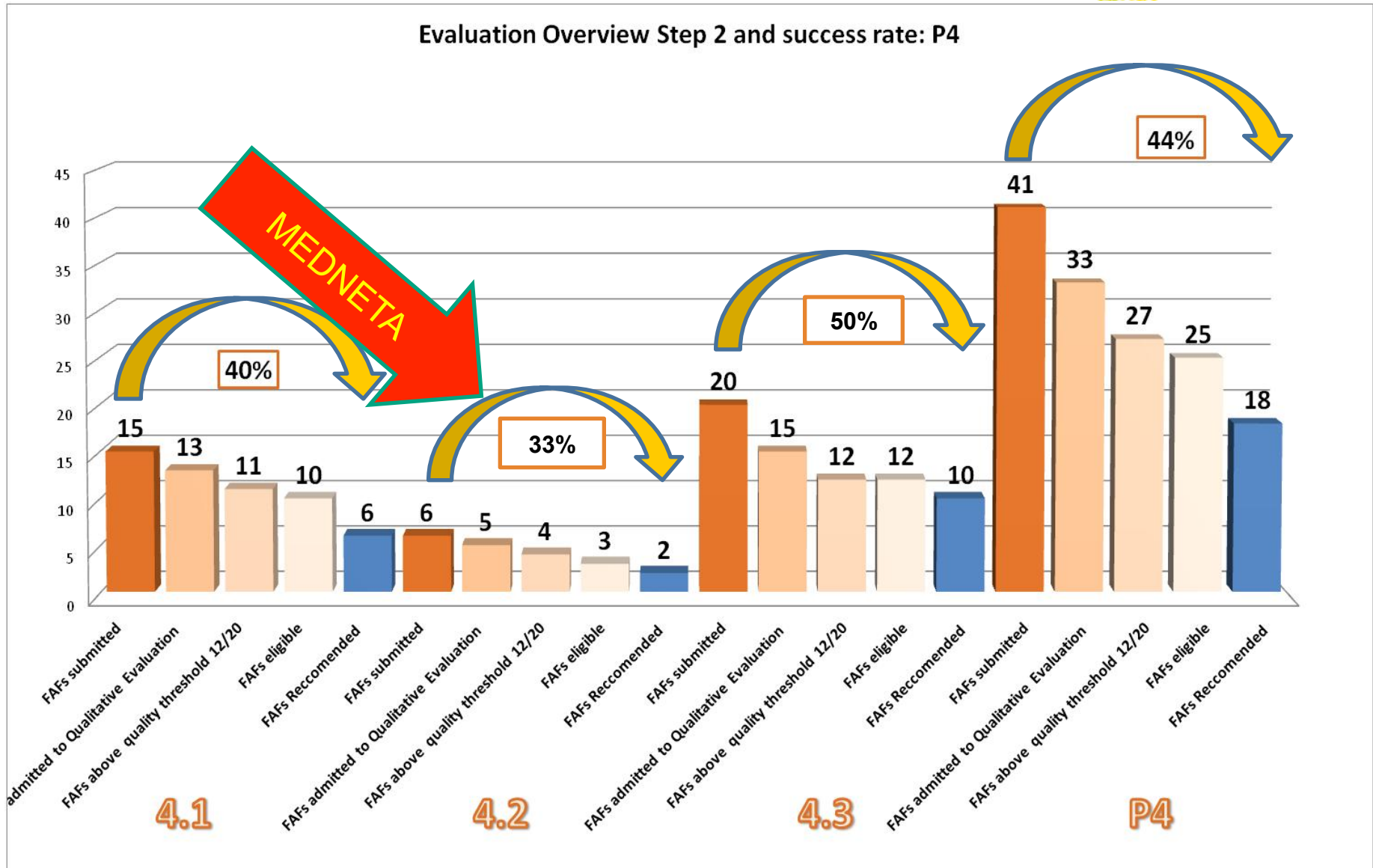

Objective and main expected results



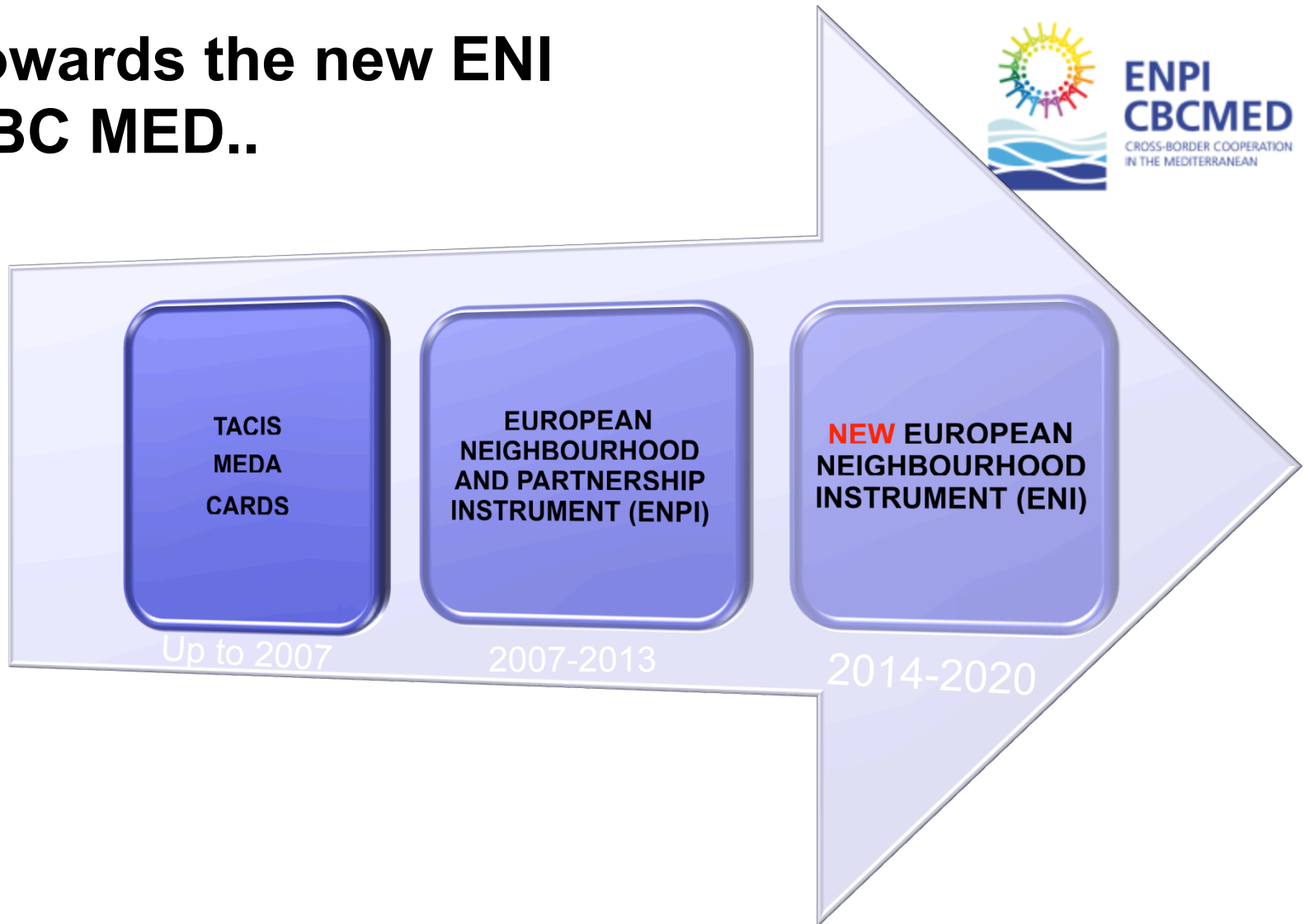
Specific Objective:

Main expected results:

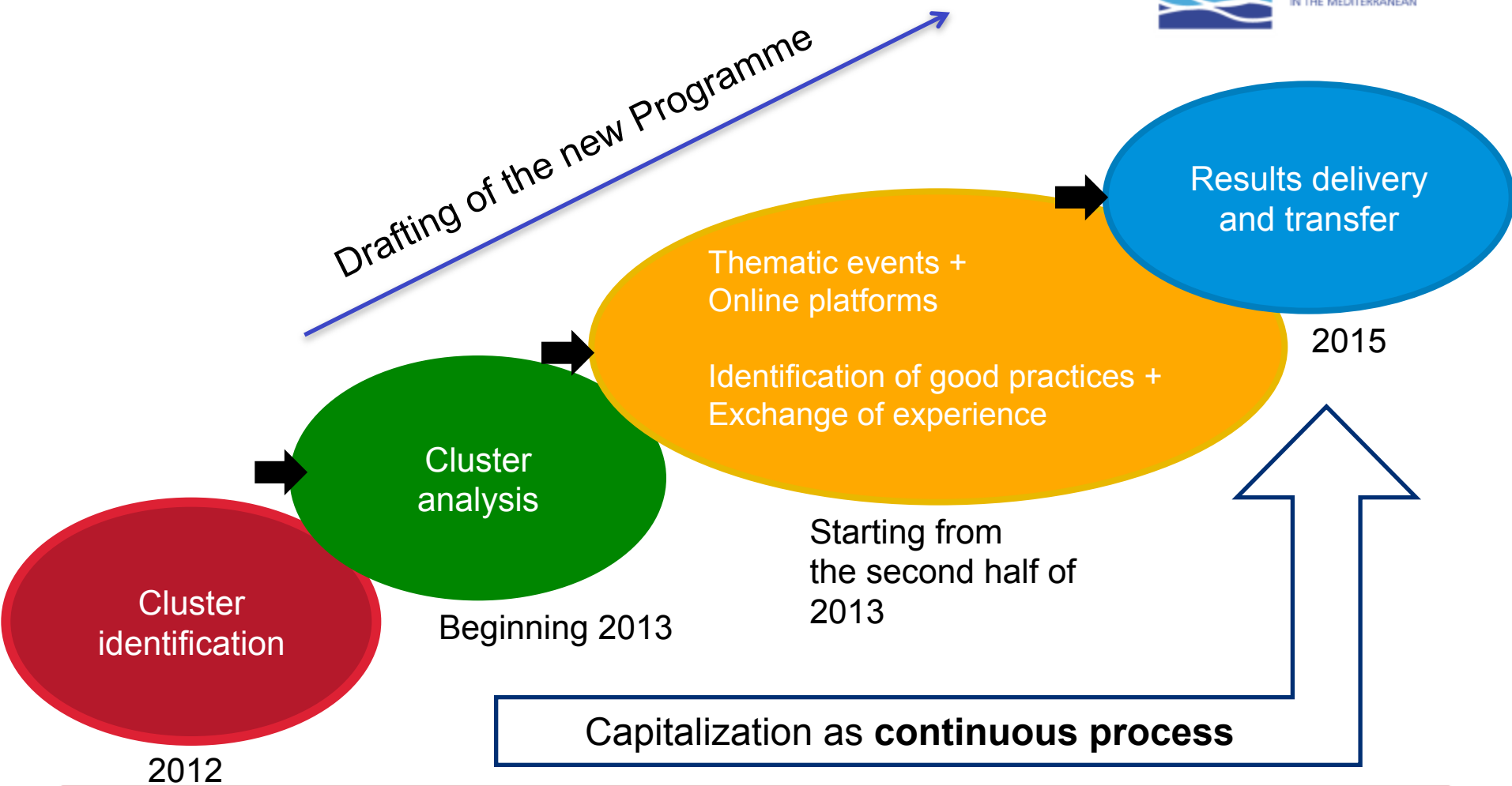
- **Sustainable urban strategies** and **pilot projects** for the **socioeconomic revitalization of historic cities**, including programs for the regeneration of ACDs.

- **Mediterranean ACDs Lab network** as an open virtual lab of multicultural dialogue and a **MEDNETA observatory** to monitor the ACDs Lab-net functioning.
