



PP5. Association for the Safeguarding of the Medina of Tunis - ASM

ASM activities focuses on: the restructuring of degraded areas, restoration and rehabilitation of social housing, historical and architectural expertise, assistance and advise of the municipality for building permits, assistance to other organizations for the safeguarding of Tunisian Medinas, etc.

ASM is the Coordinator of WP3 and participates also in all the WPs of the proposed project.

ASM will be responsible for the coordination of all activities and input from all partners for the setting up of the MEDNETA observatory in WP3.

A ASM representative will take part to the Project Management Board (PMB) and to the Scientific & Technical Committee (STC) and as a member of the Exploitation and Dissemination Committee (EDC) (WP1). ASM co-organizes with GIC communication actions in Tunis for WP5 and 1st MEDNETA Conference in Tunis, explained in WP2. ASM will be responsible for carrying out data collection and survey on local ACD's as well as preliminary data analysis (WP4). ASM will be responsible to organize the local stakeholders in order to contribute to the formulation of the joint integrated strategy through specially organized workshops and interviews, detailing in parallel the foreseen plans and programs (WP4). During WP5 ASM will have the responsibility to plan and implement the urban intervention that will take place in Tunis. In WP6 ASM will host the workshop in Tunis and organize the activities that will take place during the workshop under the guidance of the WP6 Coordinator (BZU). Through WP7 ASM will be responsible to provide a list of potential stakeholder partnerships that can engage in pilot cooperation schemes identified mainly through the workshops and the MED Forum. ASM during WP8 will facilitate the contact with local institutions in Tunis.
